5 Cash Awards of \$2,000 Each

These awards are a memorial to William A. Lee, who served as President of the Chicago Federation of Labor for 38 years. Mr. Lee devoted over 60 years to the cause of labor and civic and community service.

Applicants for the awards must have all information requested in the rules outlined on the reverse side of this announcement presented to the Chicago Federation of Labor by March 1 in the year of the applicants' graduation in order to be eligible for the competition.

The students should please note these instructions:

The union of which the parent is a member or the member applying must be affiliated with the Chicago Federation of Labor. If you want confirmation of the affiliation status, call 312-222-1000. Please make certain that the application is COMPLETED IN FULL and that it is SIGNED by the APPLICANT and by a CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER (CEO) OF THE LOCAL UNION (example: President, Recording Secretary, Financial Secretary, Business Manager). (Business Agents, Stewards, or delegates do NOT qualify as a CEO).

For members and children of members of Local Unions Affiliated with the Chicago Federation of Labor. The Chicago Federation of Labor will award five William A. Lee Memorial Scholarships of \$2,000 each to members and children of members in good standing of affiliated local unions who will graduate from Chicago area high schools. The funds paid in cash to the five students selected will be available for use at any accredited college or university in the United States.

The William A. Lee Memorial Scholarships will be awarded to the winners as soon as possible after selection. Please note that the deadline for eligibility to compete for the awards is **MARCH 1** of the year of the students' graduation.

THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES SHALL BE FINAL. Selections will be based on the high school transcripts, scores on college entrance examinations (ACT and/or SAT, etc.) and report of extra-curricular activities. Additional information may be requested by the judges of the competition.

The scholarships are entirely unrestricted as to race, religion, political affiliation or choice of accredited college or university. The awards will be paid by checks payable to the winners. There is no restriction as to income of the family nor the acceptance of other scholarship awards by the winners. Any problems must be resolved by the students. The names of the winners will be announced to all applicants and will be released to the media.

HOW TO APPLY

Applicants will receive an application form and a certificate (on reverse side) which must be filled out and signed by the high school principal or other authorized high school representative. To be eligible, each applicant must return the COMPLETED application form including the certification of union membership, high school transcripts, ACT and/or SAT or other college entrance examination scores, and a record of extra-curricular activities.

All of these papers must be returned **NO LATER THAN MARCH 1** to: WILLIAM A. LEE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE, Chicago Federation of Labor at 130 E. Randolph, Suite 2600, Chicago, IL 60601. **Incomplete information will be a cause for disqualification.**

CLOSING DATE

To be eligible, entrants must submit all the material listed above so that it will be received **NO LATER THAN MARCH 1** of the year of the students' graduation.
